1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18-2)

Beyond any boundary fence or line of white stakes defining the perimeter of the course.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

Penalty areas are defined by red and yellow stakes or lines. Stakes and/or lines defining the margins of the penalty area are in the penalty area.

3. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16-1.

Immovable obstructions close to putting green: In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is clearly unreasonable.)
